**Executive Summary
Facts and Figures
Academic Year 2006**

Lincoln University had a total unduplicated headcount of 3,951 students for Academic Year 2006 [Table 44]. Headcounts were taken from the census files for Fall 2005, Spring 2006, and Summer 2006. These included headcounts of 3,610 undergraduate students and 341 graduate students [Table 45]. The total number of credit hours generated was 70,083, with 66,644 undergraduate credit hours and 3,439 graduate credit hours [Table 43]. Freshmen comprised the largest portion of the total headcount (49%), followed by Sophomores and Seniors (15%), Juniors (14%), and Graduate students (7%) [Table 52].

Seven hundred eleven students were identified as first-time freshmen, 659 of which were full-time students and 52 of which were part-time students [Table 14]. The average ACT score for this group was 16.9, the lowest average in the five year trend period [Table 20]. Two hundred seventy students were identified as new transfer students [Table 21].

Among undergraduate headcounts, the largest ethnic group represented was White/Non-Hispanic (54.2%), followed by Black/Non-Hispanic (37.3%), Non-Resident Alien (4.3%), Hispanic (1.5%), Other/Multiple (1.2%), Asian/Pacific Islander (1.0%), and American Indian (0.5%) [Table 1]. Among graduate students, the largest ethnic group represented was also White/Non-Hispanic (68.9%), followed by Black/Non-Hispanic (16.4%), Non-Resident Alien (10.0%), Other/Multiple (3.9%), Asian/Pacific Islander (0.6%), American Indian (0.3%), and Hispanic (0.0%) [Table 35].

Approximately 60% of undergraduates were female, while approximately 40% were male [Table 1]. Among graduate students, approximately 73% were female, while approximately 27% were male [Table 35].

Students age 18-19 comprised the largest age category among undergraduates with 31% representation, followed by 20-21 (19%), 22-24 (15%), Under 18 (14%), 25-29 (9%), 30-34 (5%), 35-39 and 40-49 (3%), and 50-64 (1%). The categories of 65 and Over and Not Reported each represented less than 1% of total undergraduates [Table 6]. Students age 25-29 comprised the largest age category among graduate students with 26% representation, followed by 40-49 (21%), 30-34 (17%), 35-39 and 50-64 (12%), and 22-24 (10%). The categories of 20-21 and 65 and Over each represented less than 1% of total graduate students [Table 36].

Sixty-two percent of undergraduates attended full-time, while 38% attended part-time [Table 6]. Almost seventy percent of graduate students attended part-time, while approximately 30% attended full-time [Table 35].

The most popular undergraduate academic programs were Non-Degree-Seeking (19%), Nursing Science - AAS (14.5%), Business Administration (9.9%), Criminal Justice - BS and Undecided (5.4%), and Elementary Education (5.2%) [Table 32]. The most popular graduate academic programs were Non-Degree-Seeking (31%), Business Administration (28%), and Guidance and Counseling (19%) [Table 41].

Positive Five Year Trends: The number of credit hours generated per academic year by out-of-state students increased by 9.4% for undergraduates and 87.8% for graduate students, while the number of credit hours generated by in-state graduate students increased by 1.1% [Table 43]. Undergraduate headcounts increased for Hispanic students (49%), Black/Non-Hispanic students (9%), and Asian/Pacific Islander students (5%) [Tables 4-5]. The academic year headcount of first-time degree-seeking students increased by 9.4% [Table 14]. The number of Black/Non-Hispanic first-time degree-seeking students increased by 41.9% [Table 15]. The headcount of graduate full-time students increased by 126.1% [Table 39]. The graduate level headcount of Black/Non-Hispanic students increased by 40% [Tables 37-38]. The headcount of international students increased by 116.7% for graduate students [Table 50].

Negative Five Year Trends: The number of credit hours generated per academic year by in-state students decreased by 11.3% for undergraduates, leading to an overall decrease of 7.2% [Table 43]. The academic year headcount for undergraduates decreased by more than 4% [Table 7]. This reflected decreases of 2.3% of full-time headcounts and 7.9% of part-time headcounts [Tables 4-5]. Overall student FTE decreased by 8.5% [Table 44]. The headcount of international students decreased by 14.2% for undergraduate students and 4.5% overall [Table 50]. This reflected a decrease of 24% in the number of undergraduate non-resident aliens enrolled during the academic year [Tables 4-5]. Undergraduate headcounts also decreased for White/Non-Hispanic students (12%) and American Indian students (3%) [Tables 4-5]. The academic year headcount of new transfer students declined by 23% [Table 24]. Graduate headcounts decreased by 1.4% overall [Table 39]. This reflected a 17% decrease in the graduate level headcount of White/Non-Hispanic students [Tables 37-38], as well as a decrease of 21% of all part-time graduate students [Table 39].

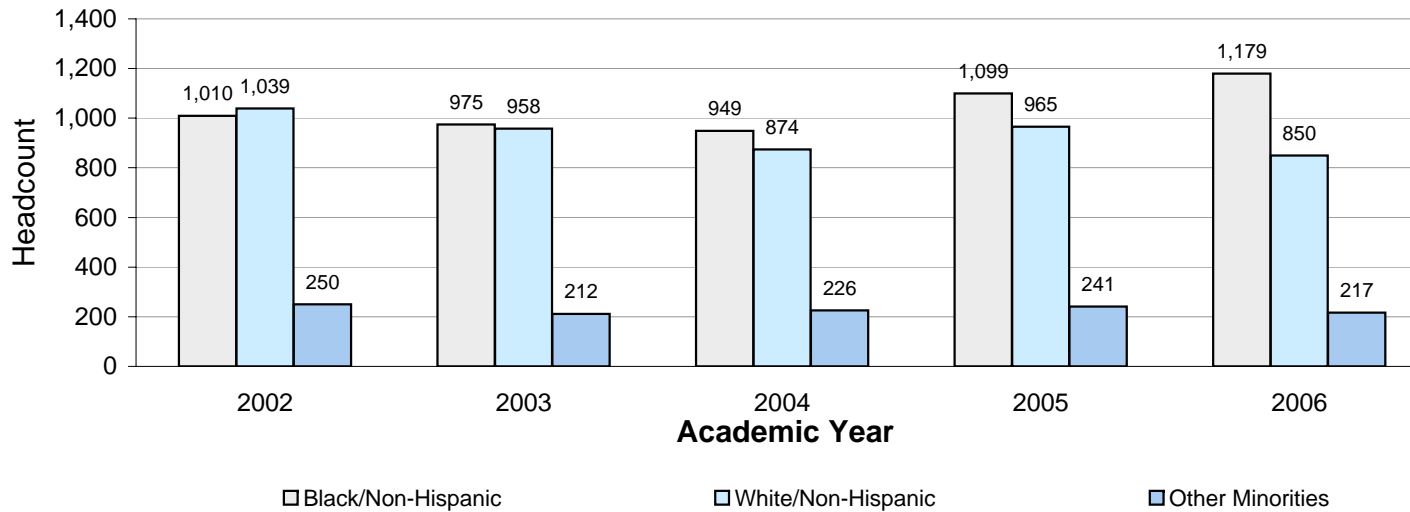

Full-Time Undergraduate Enrollment by Ethnicity

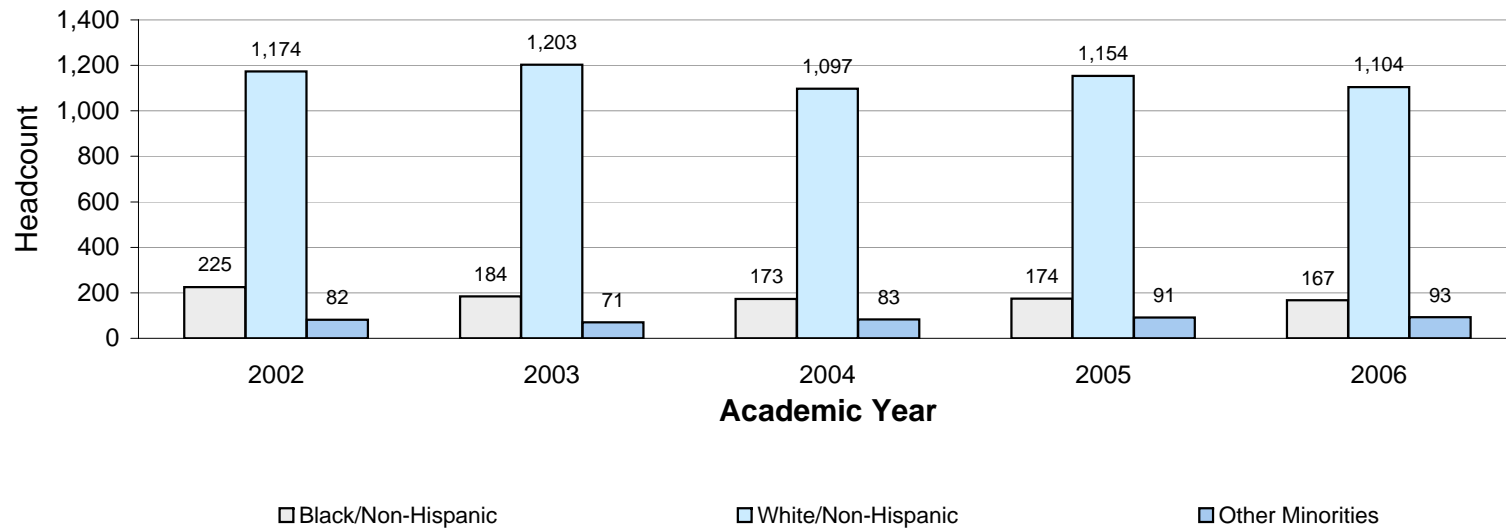

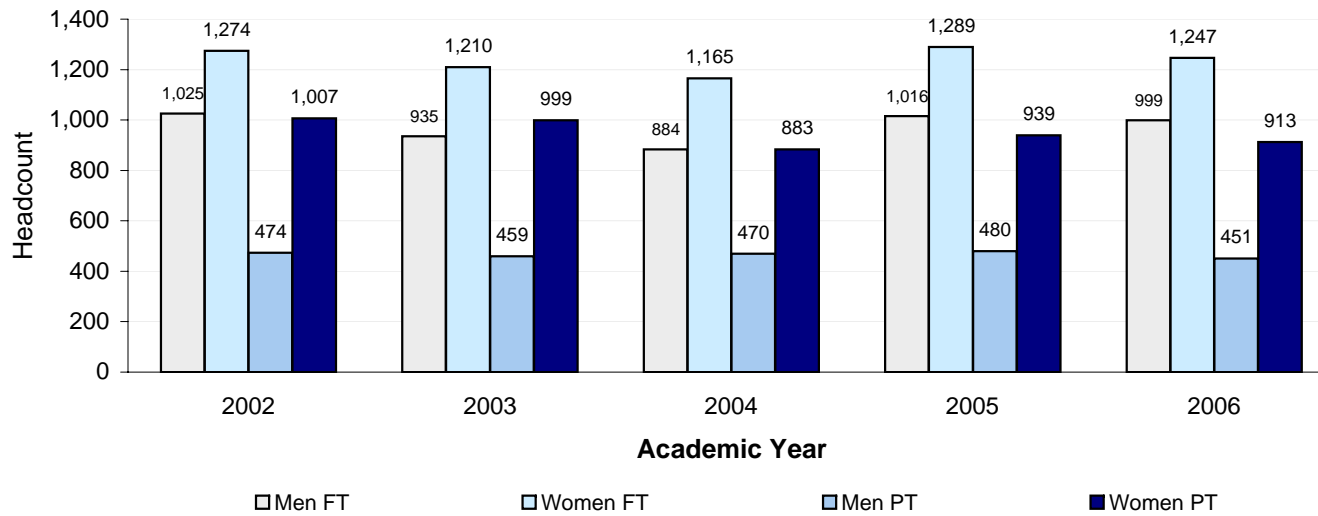

Undergraduate Students by Academic Load and Gender



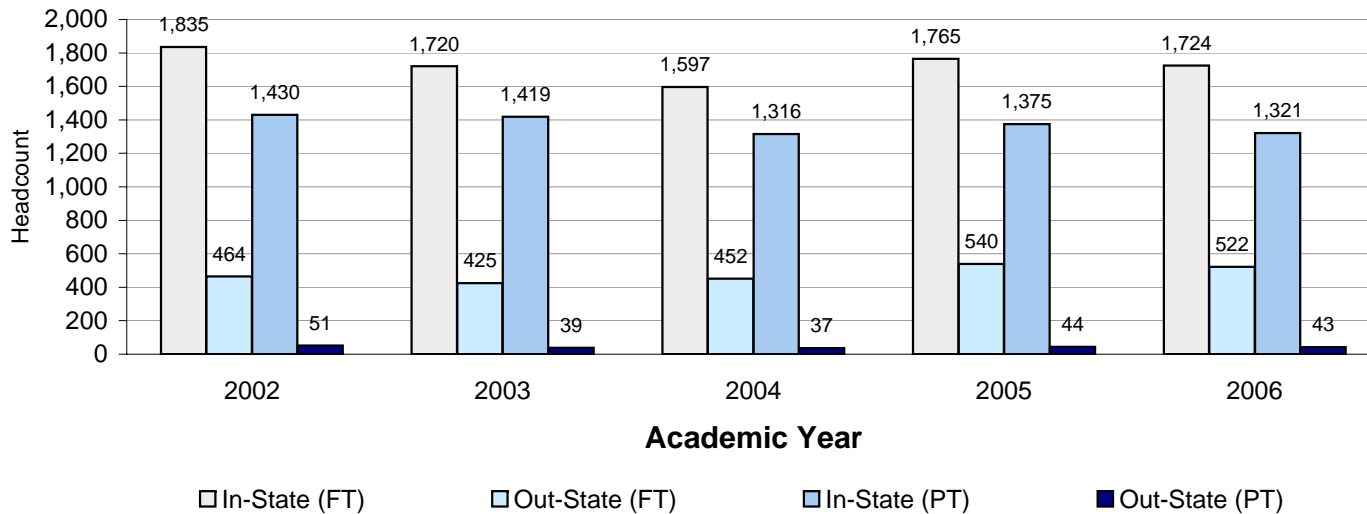

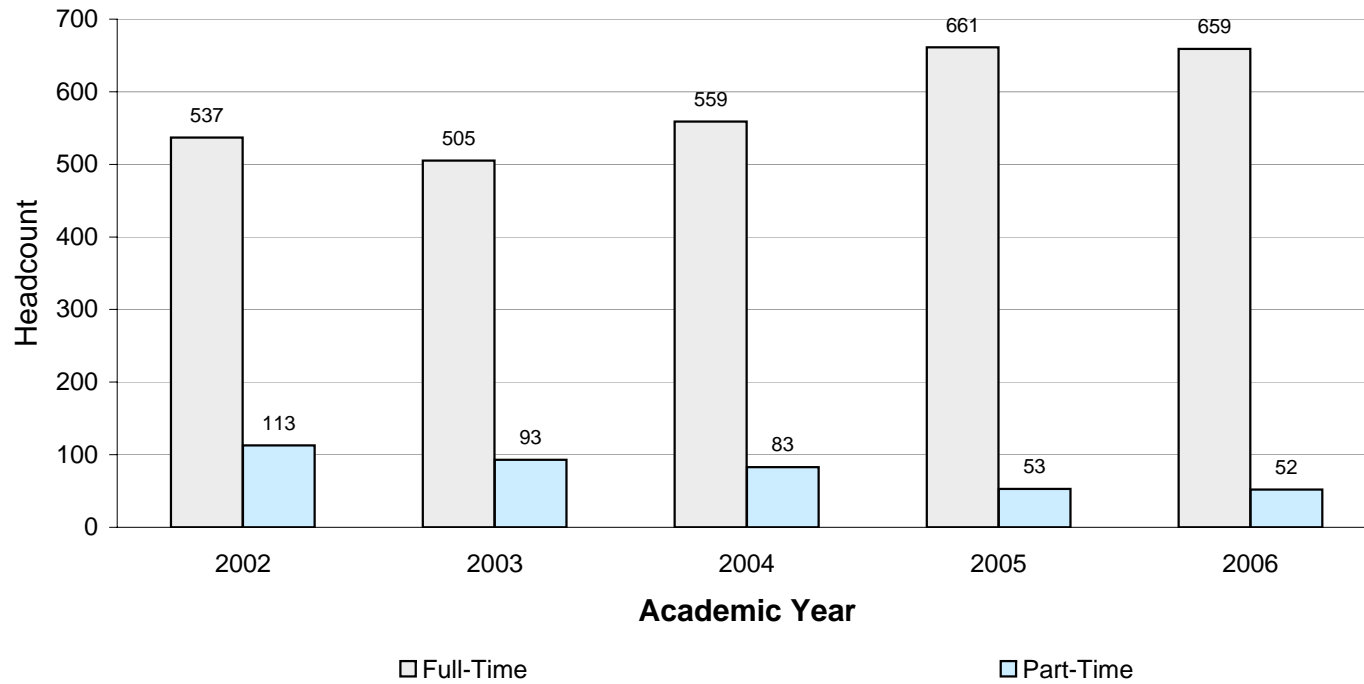

First-Time Degree-Seeking Students by Academic Load

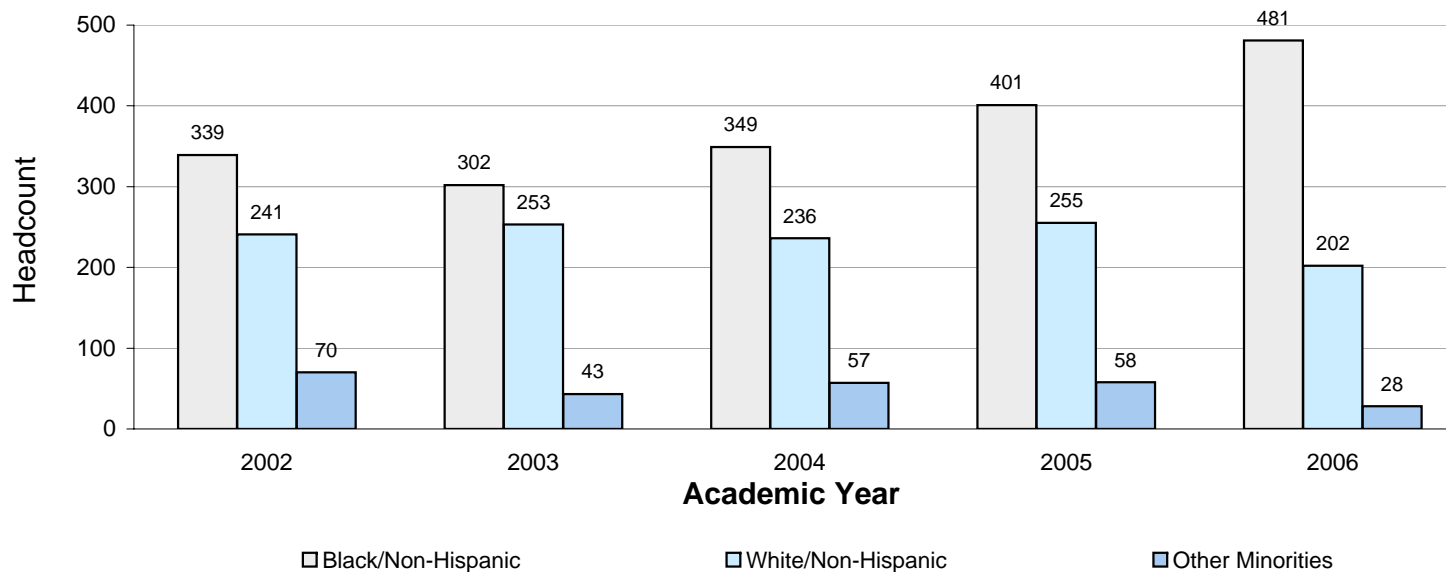

First-Time Degree-Seeking Students by Ethnicity



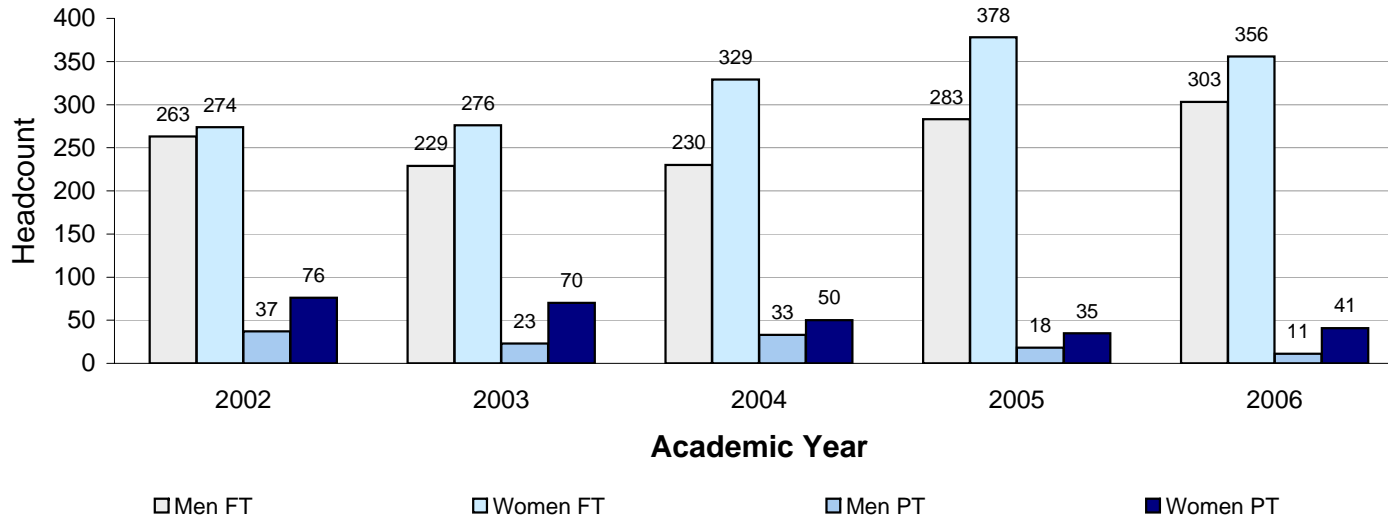

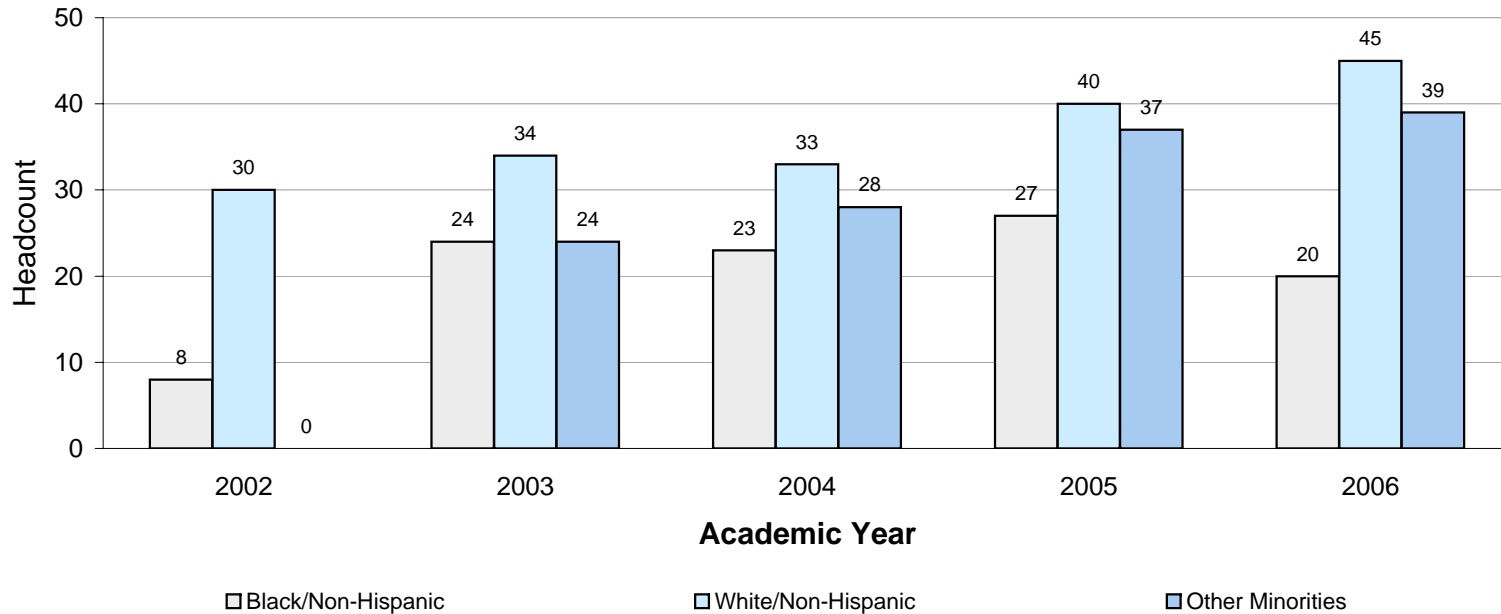

Full-Time Graduate Students by Ethnicity

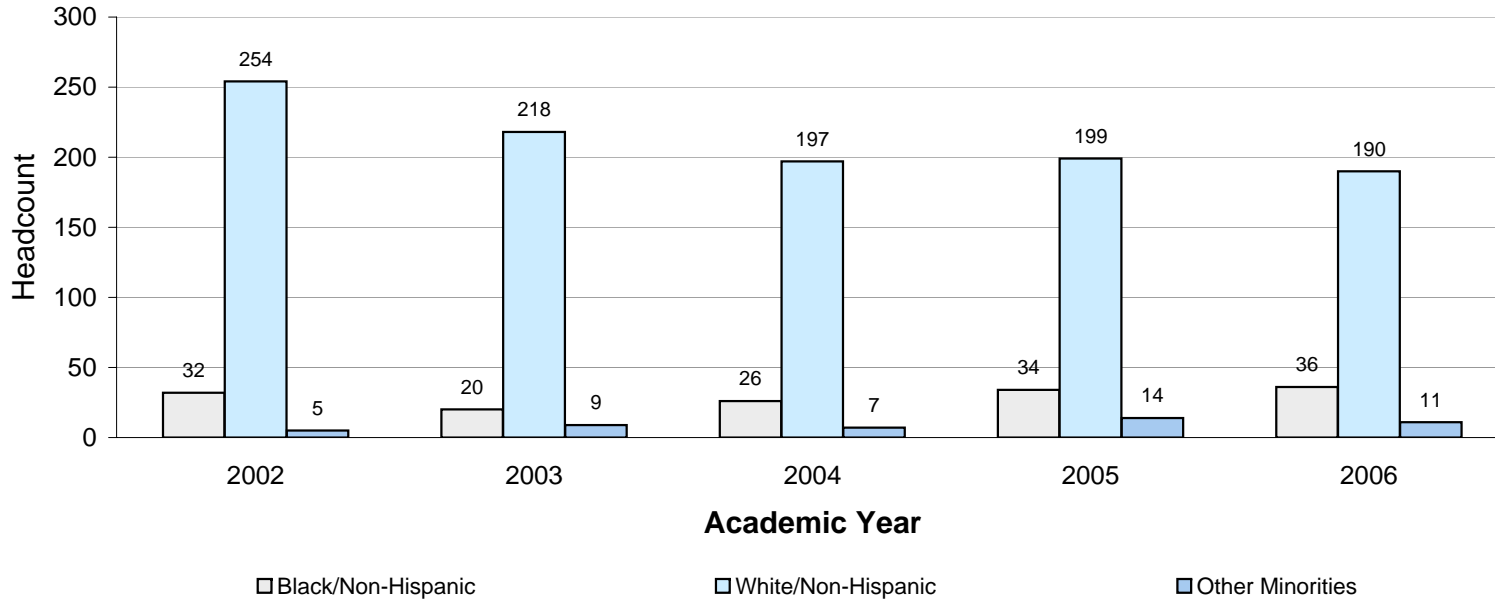

Part-Time Graduate Students by Ethnicity

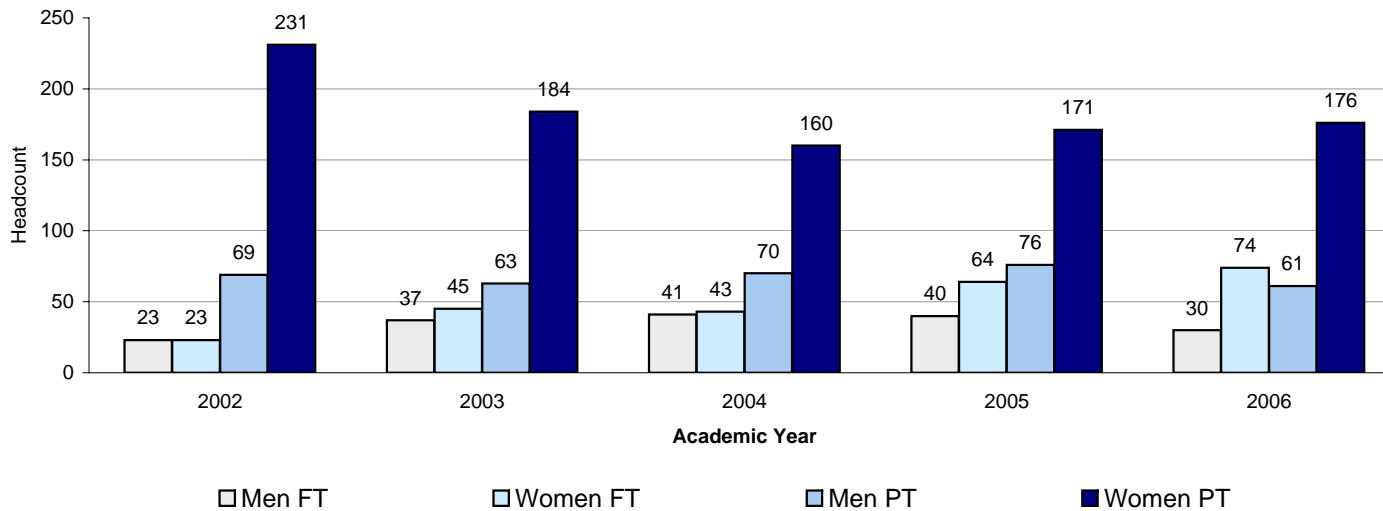

Graduate Students by Academic Load and Gender

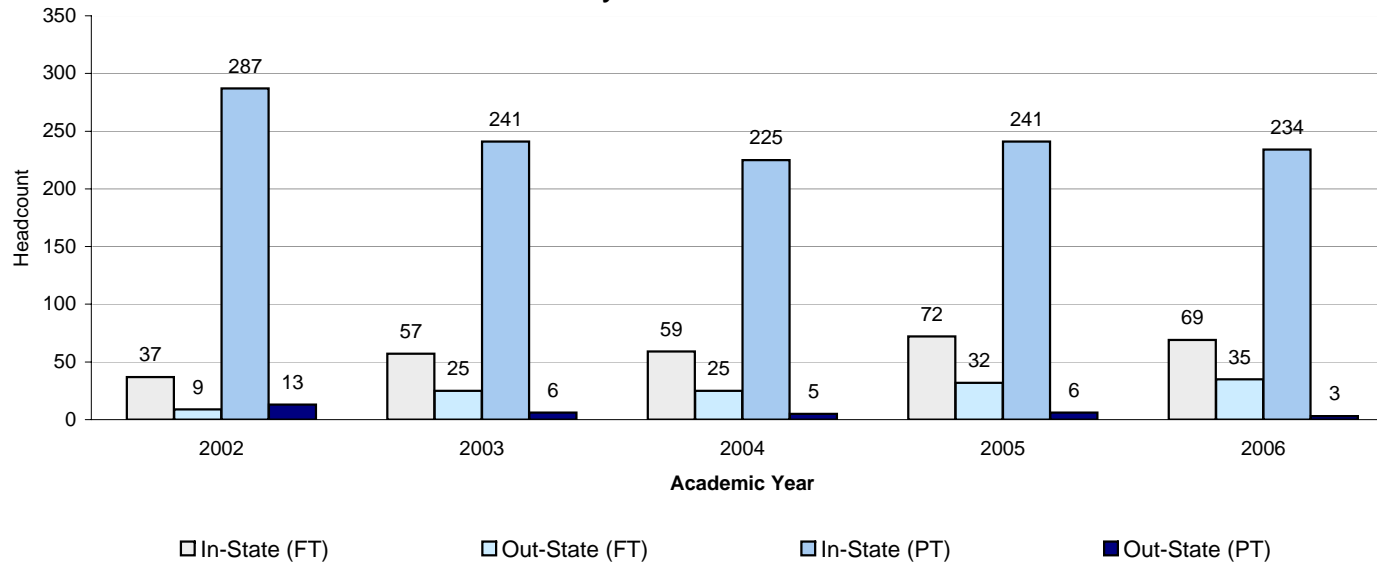

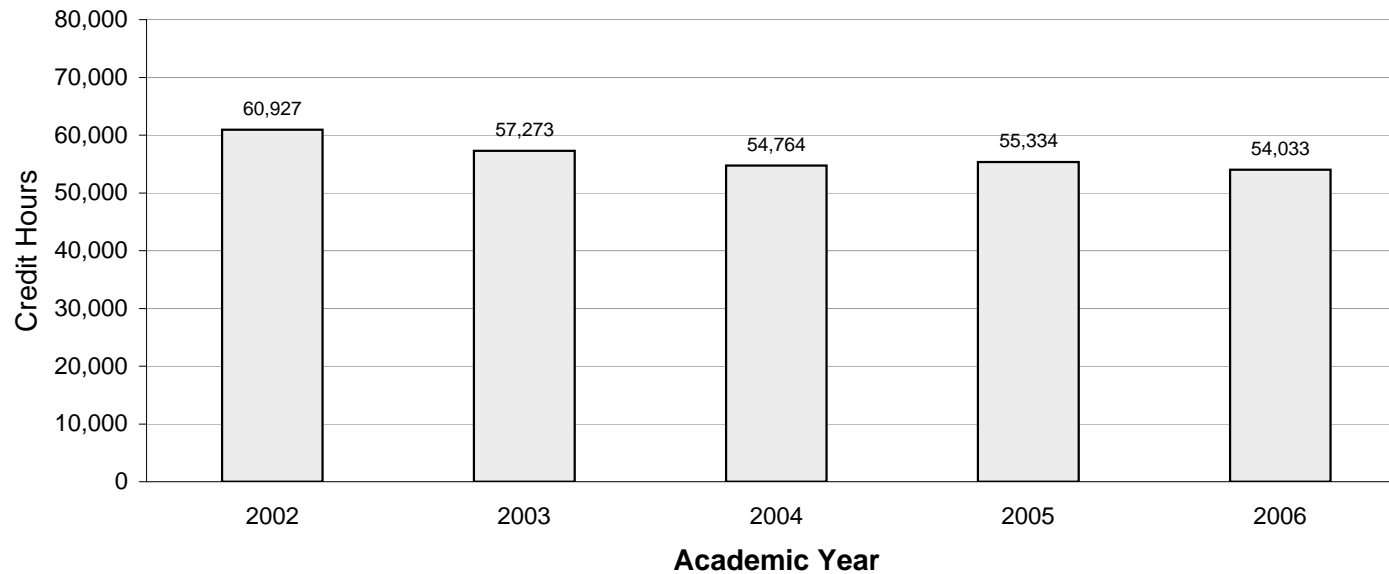

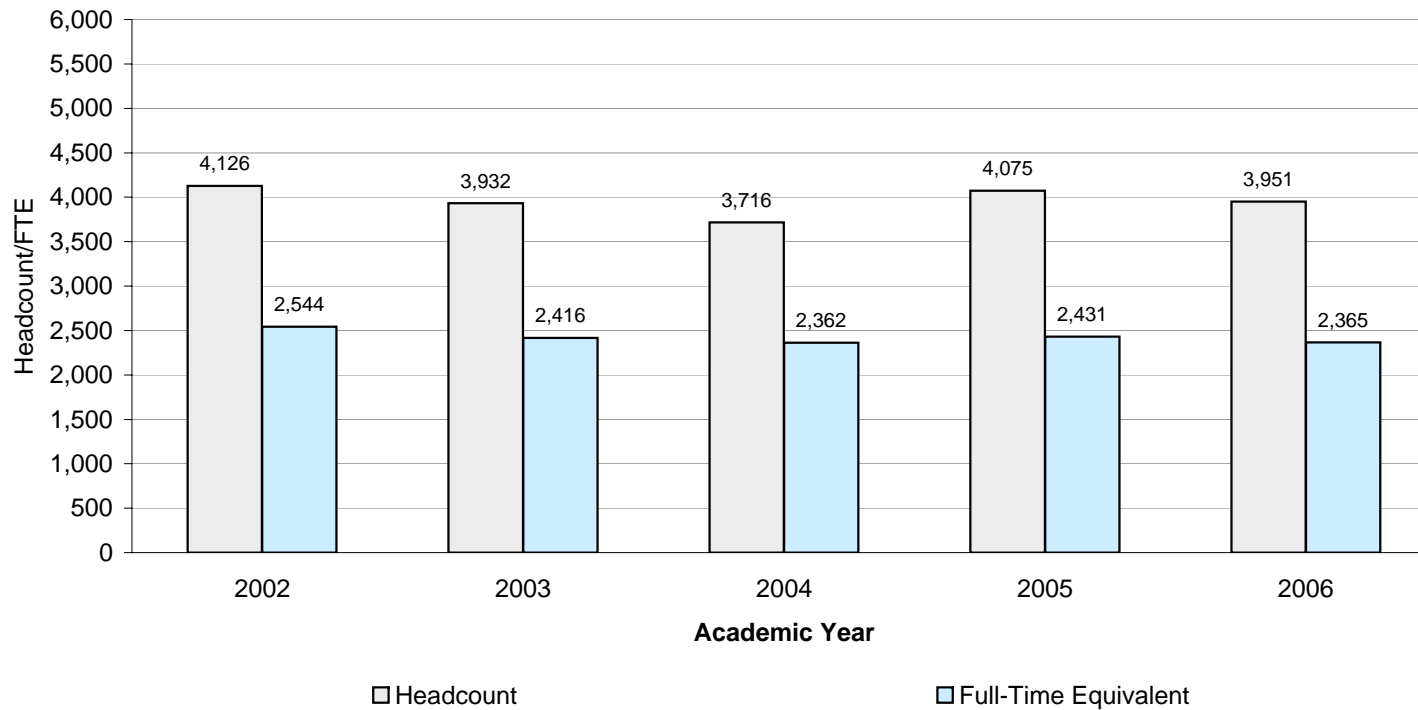

Total Student Headcount and FTE

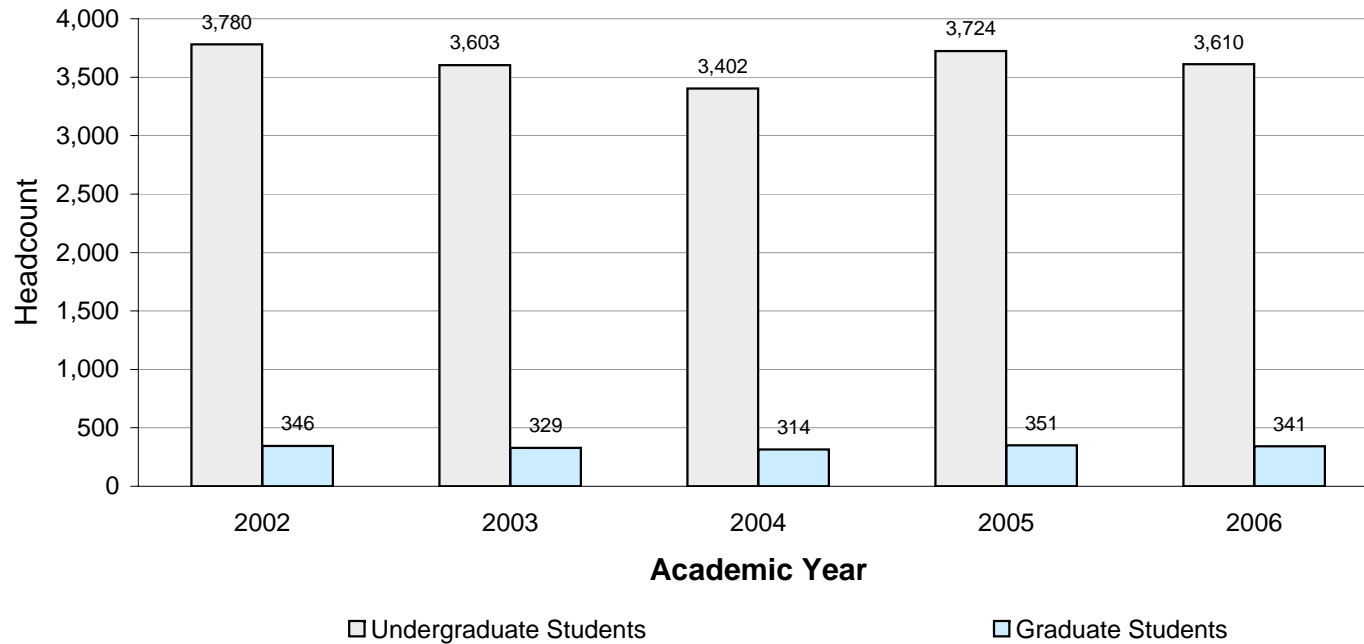

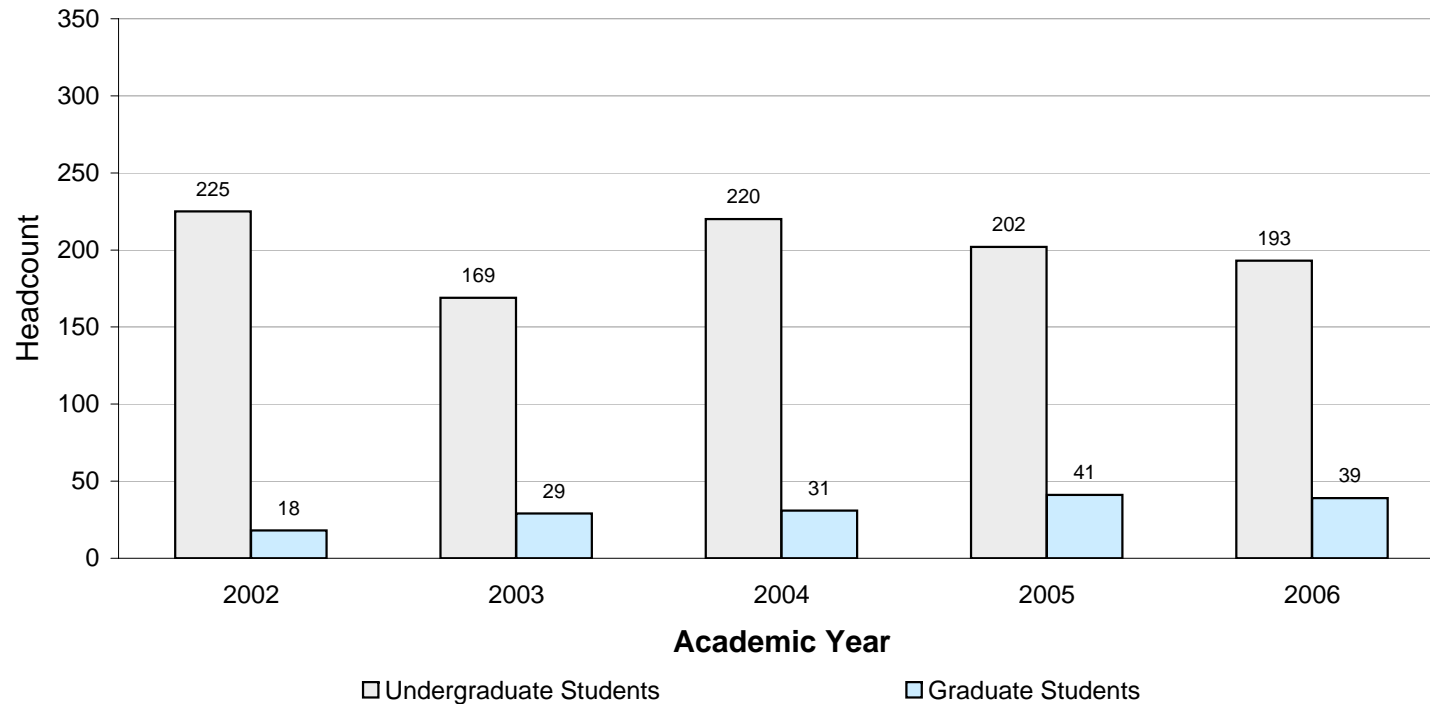
